Horticulture 332 – Interior Plantscaping WHETS class from Puyallup to Pullman, Tri-Cities and Spokane



Rita Hummel has been teaching Hort 332, Interior Plantscaping, over WHETS since spring semester 2002. The class broadcasts out of WSU Puyallup to the Pullman, Spokane and Tri-Cities campuses. The 29 students enrolled in the course are not only seeking majors in Horticulture, Landscape Architecture and Agriculture Education, but also Interior Design, Communications,

Political Science, Biology, Natural Resource Sciences and Agricultural Technology and Management. The class focuses on teaching students about selection, installation, management, maintenance and design of plantings inside buildings as well as the effects interior plants have on people and the environment. While the course is not required for the Horticulture degree, it is an elective that meets degree requirements.
